

To be eligible to attend the camp as a staff member you must be:

• An active member of The Scout Association with an adult appointment and aged 18 or over by the 3rd May 2024.

If you are: -

- A member of the Scout Network who does not hold or has not applied for an adult appointment in Scouting you must take up an adult appointment and compete the necessary conditions for the role prior to the camp.
- An Explorer Scout but will be 18 by the time of the camp, you must have completed the necessary conditions for the role you will hold prior to the camp. The earliest you can apply for your disclosure (PVG) is 6 months before your 18th birthday. More information on this process is available from your District Appointments Secretary.

All staff must have:

- 1. Completed the Appointments Process (including attending appointment advisory committee if appropriate, disclosure and references), and
- 2. Completed both of the Safety and Safeguarding modules, and they be recorded on the membership system

Additionally, prior to the camp, if you have held <u>any</u> adult appointment for more than 6 months you must have:

- 3. Completed and validated the remaining Getting Started training, relevant for your role, and it be recorded on the membership system
- 4. Kept your disclosure (PVG), Safety and Safeguarding and First Aid (if appropriate for your role) in date (covering at least the duration of the camp)

ANY APPLICATIONS THAT DO NOT MEET THE CRITERIA ABOVE PRIOR TO THE CAMP WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
